

And walk How to Create New Entries on the Tiki Toki Timeline

1. Log on to the Washington State Historical Society suffrage timeline at Tiki Toki:

2. Where you see “Edit this Timeline” in the lower left, enter your First Name and School (ie. Gus – Washington Elementary) and the password: **suffrage100wa**
3. Click “Create New Story” in the upper right corner
 - a. Under the “Basic Info” tab, include:
 - i. Title (The person’s name or event)
 - ii. Start Date (Where should this fall on the timeline?)
 - iii. End Date (Can be the same as the Start Date)
 - iv. Intro. This should be a short paragraph summarizing of the person or event. (25-50 words)
 - v. Link (This is where you cite their source with a direct link to the website)
4. Click “Save.”
5. Under the “Extra Info” Tab, you can enter a full text article about their person or event. It is not necessary to add extra info. If you wish to do so, you can tailor the length of the article.
6. Under the “Media” Tab, include the link to the online image to serve as citation. “Image Type” can be image, video, audio, etc. For “Image Caption,” write a one sentence caption for the media.
7. Click “Save.” Edit your work as needed.

STORY CONTENT

This is where you add content to the stories that appear on your timeline. We have separated this into three sections:

BASIC INFO

Here you enter basic info about your story, including its title, the date it occurred and some introductory text. You can also choose the story's category (add categories via the Categories tab) and also add a link to an external web page.

STORY MEDIA

Connect images, audio and videos (YouTube, DailyMotion, Vimeo) to your story via the Story media tab. These will be turned into image and video galleries in the popup panel that appears when visitors click on the story in your timeline.

EXTRA INFO

Access this via the Extra info tab. This is for stories that have a lot of text content. We allow this 'full text' content to be formatted with paragraphs and external links.

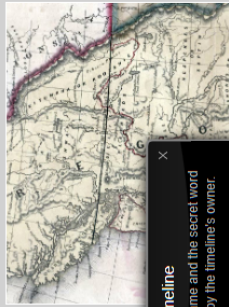
